How to Install Zinio Reader 4

Zinio Reader 4 is a program used for Zinio.com. This program will allow you to login to your Zinio account and either view your magazine or have the choice to download the magazine for view in the future while **offline**.

If this appeals to you, please follow these steps.

- Open your preferred web browser (Internet Explorer, Google Chrome, or Mozilla Firefox) and in the URL (Web Address) enter www.adobe.com
- At the Adobe Website you will see a download tab on their site. Please download the following:
 - Adobe Reader
 - Adobe Flash Player
 - Adobe Air
- Once the previous step is completed please go to the Zinio website at www.zinio.com and follow these steps:
 - Scroll to the bottom of the screen
 - Under “Get the app” click on the appropriate link for your install
 - If on windows system computer with windows 7 or earlier click PC/Mac
 - Windows 8 users please click WIN 8
 - Apple PC users click on PC/MAC
 - If on non-Iphone phone use ANDROID
 - Now the page should load with a Zinio Reader image that says “click here to download zinio reader 4”. Please click on this image.
 - Windows will prompt you for the download. You must have Adobe Air to open this program for installation.
 - Depending on your Browser these downloads will be handled differently
 - Internet Explorer will run through the download after hitting accept on the window prompt. Then when the download is finished it will continue with the installation of the Zinio Reader 4 application.
 - Mozilla Firefox will prompt for the download and then at the top right of the browser they down arrow will light up green letting you know that it has downloaded a new item. You may click on the green arrow to see the installation file and then double click on this file to run the installation.
 - Google Chrome will show the file download at the bottom of the browser after you have accepted for the download. Once it

finishes you left click on the file at the bottom and the installation will start.

- When the Application Install window pops up you will click on install.
- On the next window you have some customization options
 - You can choose to have an Icon on your desktop to double click on to start the program.
 - You can chose to have program start right after this installation is finished
 - Installation Location can be on any drive or even folder that you want it to be. For installation ease it is most likely best to stay with the default location of C:\Program Files (x86)
- The program will inform you if the installation completed and if so just click finish.
