

PUBLIC COMMENT POLICY

All persons are welcome to attend public meetings of the Board of Trustees of Westchester Public Library.

Any person wishing to address the Library Board with a comment may do so during the Public Comment agenda item, and must adhere to the following rules of conduct:

- 1. A person will be granted up to three (3) total minutes to make the comment.
- 2. In the case of a group, the group must appoint one (1) person to present the comment of the entire group.
- 3. A person must state his or her first and last name and, if applicable, the group they represent, before addressing the Library Board with the comment.
- 4. After listening to the comment, the Library Board will acknowledge the comment and may or may not engage further with the person.
- 5. If there is discussion between the Library Board and the person, the discussion will not exceed five (5) total minutes.
- 6. The Library Board may cut short any comments that are repetitive, frivolous, irrelevant, harassing, disruptive, or profane.
- 7. Comments or topics deemed by the Library Board as inappropriate for public forum will not be permitted or expounded upon.
