

COMPUTER USE POLICY

- 1. Users must read and abide by the library's Computer and Internet Acceptable Use Policy.
- 2. Patrons must be at least 18 years of age and have a valid library card or a valid library reciprocal borrower card to use a computer.
- 3. Patrons under the age of 18 years of age may be permitted by their parents/legal guardians to use computers that contain additional internet filtering software, with a valid library card or a valid library reciprocal borrower card.
- 4. Persons without a library card or reciprocal borrower card may use a computer by completing a visitor computer use form.
- 5. Patrons may use a computer for 1 (one) hour, and may renew access for an additional hour(s) if no other patrons are waiting for a computer.
- 6. If other patrons are waiting to use a computer, patrons already using a computer must relinquish the computer promptly when their allotted time expires.
- 7. Patrons wishing to work together at one computer station will be restricted to 2 (two) total people and may be permitted only if there is space to do so comfortably and they work quietly and are not disruptive to others.
- 8. Children may be permitted to accompany their parents/legal guardians using a computer only if is space to do so comfortably and they are quiet and not disruptive to others.
- 9. Viewing sexually explicit images on computers in the library is prohibited.
