 - One entry per person.
- Stories must be your own original work, but writing fanfiction is allowed.
 - Keep the contents of your story PG-13.
- Your entry must include a cover page with the title of your short story and your name.
- In the body of your email, please include your name, and best method to reach you if you are selected in the drawing. The two prize winners will be contacted by December 6th.
