FREEDOM SEEKERS

One of the most intriguing topics in U.S. history is a perfect fit for February's Black History Month: the Underground Railroad. The first person to write details about the Underground Railroad was a Pennsylvania man named William Still (*pictured*). Until his book was published, most Americans knew little about how the system worked.

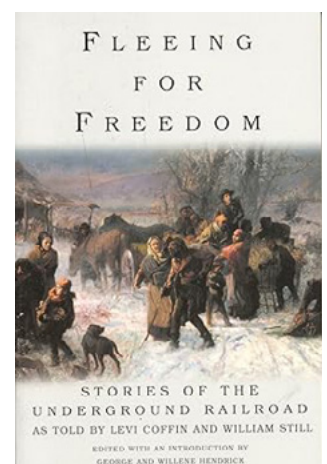
William Still's parents were both born into slavery; his father bought his own freedom, and his mother escaped. William began working on the Underground Railroad in Philadelphia in 1847. After the Civil War, his family convinced him to write about his experiences. He documented how the system worked and interviewed Harriet Tubman and freedom seekers that he had helped. He self-published his book, *The Underground Rail Road*, in 1872 and hired African Americans around the country to sell it. The National Underground Railroad Freedom Center calls his book "one of the most important historical records we have." It is unique in that it acknowledges the role of white abolitionists in the Underground Railroad but focuses on the personal narratives of the freedom seekers themselves.

1. Use your Library card to place holds (online or by phone) for up to 5 DVDs and 10 other items per card, based on the following item limits: 5 DVDs, 10 Music CDs, 5 New Books, 2 Electronic Games, 10 General Books.

2. After you receive notice that your holds are ready, drive to your branch during Curbside Pickup hours. Pull into a specially-numbered parking space.

3. Call the Library phone number posted on the numbered parking space sign and staff will check-out and bring your holds to your parking space.

4. Pickup! Roll open your window or pop your trunk and staff will bring your bagged hold items out to your parking space for you. They will conveniently close your trunk if opened.


