## FREEDOM SEEKERS

One of the most intriguing topics in U.S. history is a perfect fit for February's Black History Month: the Underground Railroad. The first person to write details about the Underground Railroad was a Pennsylvania man named William Still (pictured). Until his book was published, most Americans knew little about how the system worked.


William Still's parents were both born into slavery; his father bought his own freedom, and his mother escaped. William began working on the Underground Railroad in Philadelphia in 1847. After the Civil War, his family convinced him to write about his experiences. He documented how the system worked and interviewed Harriet Tubman and freedom seekers that he had helped. He self-published his book, *The Underground Rail Road*, in 1872 and hired African Americans around the country to sell it. The National Underground Railroad Freedom Center calls his book "one of the most important historical records we have." It is unique in that it acknowledges the role of white abolitionists in the Underground Railroad but focuses on the personal narratives of the freedom seekers themselves.
