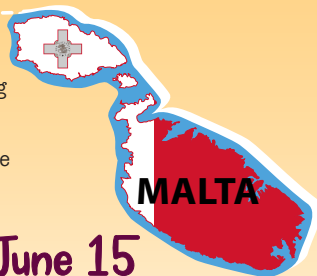

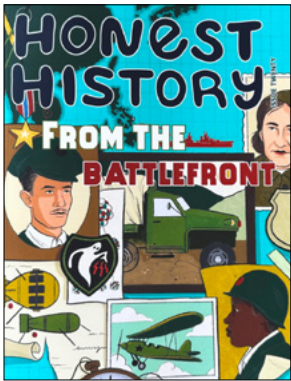

## **Honest History (Thomas & Hageman print)**

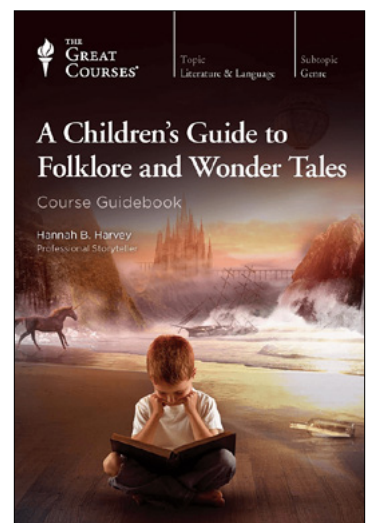
