

STUDY ROOM USE POLICY

- 1. Users must read and abide by the Library's Study Room Use Policy, and Internet Acceptable Use Policy.
- 2. Users must be at least 18 years of age and have a valid Westchester Public Library card, or a valid library reciprocal borrower card to use a study room.
- 3. Users under the age of 18 years may use a study room only if accompanied by a valid user over the age of 18, as may be the case for tutors wishing to use one of the study rooms to tutor a younger student.
- 4. Persons over the age of 18 years without a library card or reciprocal borrower card may use a study room by completing a Visitor Study Room Use Form.
- 5. Visitors may use a study room for 1 (one) hour, and may renew access for an additional hour(s) if no other patrons are waiting for a study room, for a maximum total of up to 3 hours in a single day.
- 6. If other visitors are waiting to use a study room, visitors already using a study room must relinquish the study room promptly when their allotted time expires.
- 7. Visitors wishing to work together in one study room will be restricted to 2 (two) total people and may be permitted only if there is space to do so comfortably, and they work quietly and are not disruptive to others.
- 8. Children may be permitted to accompany their parents/legal guardians using a study room only if there is space to do so comfortably, and they are quiet and not disruptive to others.
- 9. Viewing sexually explicit images on any computers or other devices, anywhere in the library (including study rooms), is prohibited.
