Barbara Walters was a force from the time TV exploded onto the American scene in the 1960s to its waning dominance in a new world of streaming services and social media half a century later. She was not just a groundbreaker for women, but expanded the big TV interview and then dominated the genre. By the end of her career, she had interviewed more of the famous and infamous, from presidents to movie stars to criminals to despots, than any other journalist in history. Then at sixty-seven, she pioneered a new form of talk TV called *The View*. Who was the woman behind the legacy?

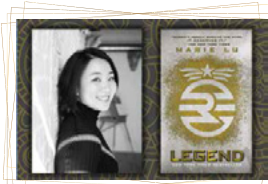

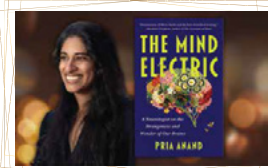

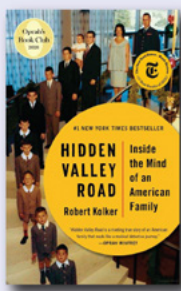
Hidden Valley Road by Robert Kolker

Don and Mimi Galvin seemed to be living the American dream. After WWII, Don's work with the Air Force brought them to Colorado, where their twelve children perfectly spanned the baby boom: the oldest born in 1945, the youngest in 1965. In those years, there was an established script for a family like the Galvins—aspiration, hard work, upward mobility, domestic harmony. But behind the scenes was a different story: psychological breakdown, sudden shocking violence, hidden abuse. By the mid-70s, six of the ten Galvin boys, one after another, were diagnosed as schizophrenic. How could all this happen to one family?



At the center of this political compromise is “federalism,” a concept referring to the balance of power between the federal and state governments. Where does state power end and federal power begin? 

3. Call the Library phone number posted on the numbered parking space sign and staff will check-out and bring your holds to your parking space.

4. Pickup! Roll open your window or pop your trunk and staff will bring your bagged hold items out to your parking space for you. They will conveniently close your trunk if opened.


