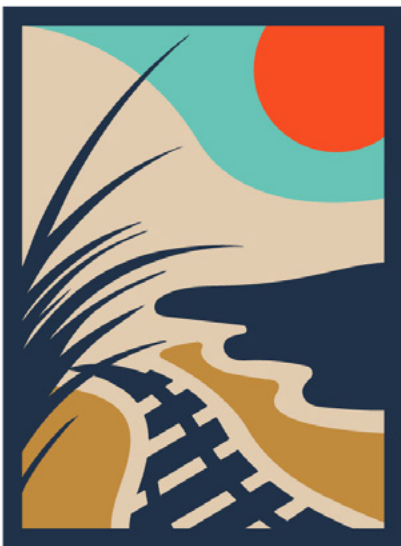

We welcome everyone to join us at the official groundbreaking ceremony on Thursday, July 30th at 6:30 PM. We look forward to sharing our plans and excitement for this project with you! Stay up to date with construction progress and news at dunelandhistorycenter.org.

Westchester Public Library is pleased to announce a major initiative to preserve regional history through the restoration of the historic Brown Mansion (1885) and the construction of a new barn expansion. This project signifies the formal transition of the Westchester Township History Museum into the Duneland History Center, a name chosen to express a broader, more inclusive vision for the lakeshore region’s shared stories.

We are embarking on a ‘bone-deep’ restoration of the Mansion, which the Museum has called home since 2005 — addressing important structural needs including plaster repair, roof replacement, and HVAC modernization— not just to maintain the building, but to rescue it from environmental decay and ensure it remains a safe, permanent home for our community’s stories for generations to come.

The project also includes a faithful replication of the property’s original 1885 barn. This new building will provide modern functionality that a Victorian home cannot offer, housing research space and a program room on a fully ADA-accessible main floor. The expansion will also allow us to create climate-controlled archival storage for our collections. Our ultimate goal is to build a safe, welcoming, and accessible hub for our research materials, archives, and artifacts so every visitor has an
